

Have your say: Draft Timber Reserve Master Plan

July 2026

We've prepared a draft master plan for Timber Reserve in Doncaster, shaped by community feedback from our first round of consultation in 2025. We're now asking for your feedback on the draft plan.

What is proposed?

A new sports pavilion including:

- gender-inclusive change rooms
- upgraded social room and kitchen
- spaces for match officials, first aid and storage
- improved spectator amenities
- public toilets.

Other upgrades

- reconfigured soccer pitches to meet Football Victoria guidelines
- a reconstructed cricket pitch to meet Cricket Australia standards
- enhanced informal recreation and play features
- new and improved footpaths
- improved car parking.

Vehicle access

We're considering a proposal to close the Marianne Way entrance to cars. Pedestrian access would stay open.

Where is it happening?

Timber Reserve is in Doncaster, with the main entrance on Anthony Avenue. The reserve can also be accessed from Timber Ridge, Marilyn Street and Marianne Way
